Acts—Church On Fire Speaker: Pastor Ryan Act 9

SMALL GROUPS

In Acts 10, Cornelius the centurion was visited by an angel (Acts 10:3-4). Being totally "freaked out" is a common denominator for those who are visited by angels in scripture. Why do you think this is? What are some things on earth that have caused you to be "awed"? Imagine how much more scary and awesome it would be to see God face to face. Hypothesis how you will react when this eventually happens.

Was there anything that stood out to you in the Acts 10 sermon from the "Church on Fire" series?

God brought the Gentiles in. (Acts 10:28)

-Peter invited the "unclean" into his house (Acts 10:23). Read Ephesians 2:11-13. How should Peter's invitation be an example for us?

-Read Matthew 25:37-40 and 1 Timothy 1:15 Who would be considered the "unclean" or sinners in our culture? Who would be considered "the least"?

-In Acts 10:44-45, God gave the Holy Spirit to the Gentiles. This would have legitimized their inclusion into the faith in the eyes of the Jewish believers. Read Matthew 7:15-20 and Galatians 5:22-23 How is the work of the Holy Spirit in one's life an important measure for us to consider in ourselves and those around us?

-Read Acts 10:15. "Do not call anything unclean that God has made pure" How does this pertain to your sin and personal holiness?

What does the Bible say about what will happen to God fearing people from other faiths or who have not heard about Jesus?

When God chooses you, you will choose God You can't choose God if he doesn't choose you (Romans 8:30) -If you are a follower of Jesus, how does it feel that you have been chosen?

-Read Philippians 2:13, Matthew 11:27 and Ephesians 1:11 How should these passages affect how we share the gospel with people?

-Read Isaiah 25:9, 61:10, Psalm 13:5 and Exodus 15:2. What should our response be to the Lord's Salvation?

"Good" people need Jesus too

Good people are not good enough for God. Jesus said you have to be perfect. (Matthew 5:48)

-Do you know anyone who claims they have "done enough good things" to "make it to heaven"? What is your response to such a claim?

-As a Christian, your righteousness comes from Jesus (1 Corinthians 1:30). What, then, should your motivation be to become more holy? Romans 12:1 gives us an idea. Can you think of more scripture passages that speak to this?
