#### **Ezekiel 28:1-19**

The word of the LORD came to me: <sup>2</sup> "Son of man, say to the ruler of Tyre, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says:

"In the pride of your heart you say, "I am a god; I sit on the throne of a god in the heart of the seas."

# How Not To Serve!

#### 1. Pride
