Romans: Life through faith in Jesus



## Romans 6

What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? <sup>2</sup> By no means! We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? <sup>3</sup> Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup> We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.




## Romans 6

<sup>5</sup> For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his.

<sup>6</sup> For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin—<sup>7</sup> because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.

## Romans 6

<sup>8</sup> Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. <sup>9</sup> For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. <sup>10</sup> The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.



## Romans 6

<sup>11</sup> In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. <sup>12</sup> Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. <sup>13</sup> Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.



- 1. You are united with Jesus.**
- 2. You are dead to sin.**
- 3. You are alive in Jesus**



Romans 6:5 ...we have been united with him in...death

2 Cor. 5:14 ...because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.

Gal. 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live...



**Romans 6:5** For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his.

**Gal. 2:20** I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me.

**Col. 2:12** having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through your faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.



Col. 3:1 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

2 Cor. 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!



## 4. Therefore, don't let sin reign.

Romans 6:12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.

1 John 4:4 the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.



## 5. Offer yourselves to God.

Romans 6:13 ...offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.



## 5. Offer yourselves to God.

1 Cor. 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

James 5:16 confess your sins to each other...



## 5. Offer yourselves to God.

Matt. 5:29 <sup>29</sup> If your right eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell.

1 Thess. 5:17 pray continually



## 5. Offer yourselves to God.

Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.

Phil. 4:8 <sup>8</sup> Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.



## 5. Offer yourselves to God.

Phil 2:13 for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.
